Eugene Scottish Festival – May 28, 2016

The 14th Annual Eugene Scottish Festival was held at the Irving Grange, and it was very well attended. In addition to clan tents and a number of vendors, there were athletic and sheep dog demonstrations, a kids area, entertainment on the indoor stage, and wagon rides. A dozen clans were in attendance.
